

Prayer for the Persecuted Church

"Comfort, comfort my people," says your God." Isaiah 40:1 "Remember those who are in prison, as though in prison with them, and those who are mistreated, since you also are in the body." Hebrews 13:3

Global Watchdog Open Doors reports that in just the last year...

- Over 365 million Christians live in places where they experience high levels of persecution and discrimination.
- 4,998 Christians were killed for their faith.
- 14,766 churches and other Christian buildings were attacked.
- 295,120 believers detained without trial, arrested, sentenced, or imprisoned.

These numbers are heart-breaking. And sadly, they do not tell the whole story.

General Pray:

- Whatever their circumstances, God will give persecuted Christians the right words. (Ephesians 6:19-20)
- That persecuted Christians will understand and find peace in the sufficiency of God's grace, even in their weakness. (2 Corinthians 12:9)
- That Christians facing hardship will draw from a source of power larger than themselves. (2 Corinthians 1:7-9)
- God be present in their hardship, protecting them according to His will.
- That their witness would inspire those who seek to harm them.

<u>Algeria</u>

Persecution Type: Islamic Oppression, Dictatorial paranoia, Clan Oppression, Ethno-Religious Hostility

Main Religion: Islam Government: Presidential Republic Leader: President Abdelmadjid Tebboune

How You Can Pray for Algeria

- Almost every Protestant church in Algeria has been forcibly closed or fears it will be soon. Pray that God will allow these places of worship to remain open.
- In Algeria, sharing your faith in Jesus is risky: it's illegal to 'shake the faith of a Muslim'. Ask God to give His people both wisdom and boldness, and pray that they will be protected if and when they share their faith.
- Pray that every believer in Algeria will be able to find a Christian community where they can enjoy fellowship.

<u>Burkina Faso</u>

Persecution Type: Islamic Oppression, Organized Corruption and Crime, Dictatorial Paranoia Main Religion: Islam

Government: President Republic

Leader: President Ibrahim Traore

How You Can Pray for Burkina Faso

- Violence in Burkina Faso has led to a massive displacement crisis. Pray for believers who are displaced by Islamist militants. Ask God to bring them hope and healing.
- Pray for believers who have endured violence. Ask God to bind up their wounds.
- Pray for church leaders who have been forced to flee their homes and villages yet still hope to minister to their flocks. Pray that God will encourage and strengthen these shepherds.

<u>Morocco</u>

Persecution Type: Islamic oppression, Dictatorial paranoia Main Religion: Islam Government: Parliamentary Constitutional Monarchy Leader: King Mohammed VI

How You Can Pray for Morocco

- Please pray that God will help the Moroccan church be salt and light.
- Pray that Christians will be wise and courageous as they live for Jesus and work out how to share their faith.
- Pray that converts from Islam facing pressure from their families and communities will find hope and peace.

<u>Laos</u>

Persecution Type: (Post) Communist Oppression, Dictatorial paranoia, Clan oppression **Main Religion:** Buddhism

Government: Communist Party-led State

Leader: President Thongloun Sisoulith

How You Can Pray for Laos

- In tribal areas, Christians can be expelled from their villages because of their faith. Pray that God will help these believers find a safe place to live and worship Him.
- Pray for the families of pastors and other church leaders who have been killed. Ask God to heal their wounds.
- Pray for the Lord's protection over Christians who are monitored and forced to meet under the watchful eye of the Communist authorities.
