# Sanctify (set apart as holy) them by the truth; Your word is truth. John 17:17

In our walk with God, the **baptism of love** and the **baptism of power** are foundational for transformation and effective ministry. Jesus doesn't just save us; He fills us—with His love and with His Spirit.

## Baptism of Love – The Father's Love Poured Out

"And hope does not disappoint us, because God's love has been poured out into our hearts through the Holy Spirit who has been given to us." — Romans 5:5

The baptism of love is an overwhelming experience of God's affection. It heals wounds, restores identity, and drives out fear. When we are immersed in His love, we begin to see ourselves and others the way He does.

## **Prayer Point:**

Lord, pour out Your love in my heart by Your Spirit. Let me experience the depth of Your affection and be rooted in Your love. Heal every place of fear and rejection with Your perfect love.

## Baptism of Power – Clothed with Power from On High

"But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses..." — Acts 1:8

This power is not for performance but for purpose—to be bold witnesses and carry out Jesus' mission with signs, wonders, and authority. It's supernatural empowerment for supernatural work.

## **Prayer Point:**

Father, I ask for the baptism of Your Spirit's power. Clothe me with boldness and authority to be Your witness in my home, city, and beyond. Let miracles, wisdom, and courage flow through me.

## Love and Power Together – God's Nature and His Strength

*"For the Spirit God gave us does not make us timid, but gives us power, love and self-discipline."* — 2 Timothy 1:7

The Holy Spirit gives both love and power. Power without love can harm. Love without power lacks transformation. But together, they reflect the heart and hand of God.

## **Prayer Point:**

Holy Spirit, baptize me in both love and power. Let me move in Your compassion and Your strength. Make me bold, balanced, and effective in fulfilling my calling.

## Faith in a Fractured World: Week 1

## 1. Build Unbreakable Faith from God's Word

## Based on Matthew 7:24-25

"Therefore everyone who hears these words of mine and puts them into practice is like a wise man who built his house on the rock..."

## • Prayer Point 1:

Lord, help me to not only hear Your Word but to put it into daily practice so that my life is rooted in Your unshakable truth. **(Matthew 7:24)** 

## • Prayer Point 2:

God, when storms come, strengthen my faith through Your Word so I stand firm, unmoved by fear or doubt. **(Matthew 7:25)** 

## 2. Build Unbreakable Faith with God's People

## Based on Hebrews 10:24-25

"Let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds, not giving up meeting together..."

# • Prayer Point 1:

Father, help me to build strong, faith-filled relationships that encourage, sharpen, and inspire me to walk boldly in Christ. **(Hebrews 10:24)** 

• Prayer Point 2:

Lord, give me a heart that values gathering with Your people so that I am not isolated but growing through community and unity. **(Hebrews 10:25)** 

## 3. Build Unbreakable Faith in God's Presence

## Based on Isaiah 40:31; Isaiah 26:3; Psalm 46:10; Psalm 37:7-8

• Prayer Point 1:

God, teach me to wait on You daily so that I may be renewed with strength, soaring above fear and fatigue in Your presence. **(Isaiah 40:31)** 

• Prayer Point 2:

Lord, as I quiet my heart before You, keep me in perfect peace and help me trust You fully, letting go of anxiety and striving. **(Isaiah 26:3; Psalm 46:10; Psalm 37:7-8)** 

# 1. Something is Happening

Hebrews 11:6 – "And without faith it is impossible to please God..."

# • Prayer Point 1:

Lord, stir my heart with unshakable faith that pleases You, even when I can't see what You're doing yet. (Hebrews 11:6)

# • Prayer Point 2:

Father, help me come boldly to You, believing that You reward those who seek You—something is happening even now! (Hebrews 11:6)

# 2. Faith for Miracles

John 20:30-31 – "But these are written that you may believe that Jesus is the Messiah... and that by believing you may have life in his name."

- Prayer Point 1: Jesus, I believe You are still working miracles today—let my faith activate Your power in my life. (John 20:30-31)
- Prayer Point 2:

Lord, as I read Your Word and remember Your works, let my belief in You bring life, healing, and breakthrough. (John 20:31)

# 3. Jesus Heals Today

Hebrews 13:8 "Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever..."

• Prayer Point 1:

Jesus, You have not changed—what You did then, You still do now. I believe You are my Healer today. **(Hebrews 13:8)** 

• Prayer Point 2:

God, I stand in faith for healing, trusting in Your promise that one day all pain and tears will be no more. **(Revelation 21:4)** 

## 4. Believing Jesus For

## Mark 9:14-29; John 16:23,27-28; Luke 4:17-21

## • Prayer Point 1:

Lord, even when my faith feels weak, I cry out like the father in Mark: "I believe, help my unbelief!" Do what only You can do. **(Mark 9:24)** 

## • Prayer Point 2:

Jesus, I believe You came to heal, deliver, and restore. I receive Your Word and declare this is the year of Your favor over my life. **(Luke 4:18–21)** 

## **Final Declaration Prayer Point**

John 6:28–29 – "The work of God is this: to believe in the one he has sent."

## • Prayer Point:

Jesus, I choose to believe in You—the One the Father sent. Let my faith in You unlock the work of God in and through me. **(John 6:28–29)** 

## Faith in a Fractured World: Week 3

## Finding Faith: Hebrews 12:1–13

• Prayer Point 1:

Lord, help me lay aside every weight and sin that hinders me. Strengthen me to run this race of faith with endurance, keeping my eyes fixed on Jesus. **(Hebrews 12:1-2)** 

• Prayer Point 2:

Father, in every trial and correction, teach me to see Your love and trust Your process. Let hardship shape my faith, not shake it. **(Hebrews 12:5-11)** 

## Spiritual Habit 1: Time in the Word

• Prayer Point 1:

God, give me a hunger for Your Word. Let it train, correct, and equip me so I may grow in righteousness and purpose. (2 Timothy 3:16–17)

• Prayer Point 2:

Lord, let Your Word be a lamp to my feet and a light to my path—guiding my decisions, strengthening my faith, and revealing Your truth. **(Psalm 119:105)** 

## **Spiritual Habit 2: Prayer**

• Prayer Point 1:

Father, help me build a lifestyle of unceasing prayer—turning to You first in every moment, with confidence and trust. (1 Thessalonians 5:17)

• Prayer Point 2:

God, I bring my anxieties before You with thanksgiving. Fill me with Your peace that surpasses understanding and guards my heart and mind. **(Philippians 4:6–7)** 

## **Spiritual Habit 3: Meditation**

• Prayer Point 1:

Lord, teach me to meditate on Your Word day and night. Let it renew my mind and keep me rooted in Your will. (Joshua 1:8)

• Prayer Point 2:

God, may I delight in Your law and dwell on it daily so I may flourish like a tree planted by water, bearing fruit in every season. **(Psalm 1:2–3)**
